2021 Course Schedule

Purpose

TNCC empowers nurses with the knowledge, critical thinking skills, and hands-on training to provide expert care for trauma patients.

Objectives

A Systematic Approach of Initial Assessment

The A – I mnemonic and the Trauma Nursing Assessment will assist nurses in providing appropriate and early intervention.

Hands-on Training Using Both an Individual and Team Approach

TNCC uses a flipped classroom model. Core concepts are taught via online modules and interactive web-based programs. Classroom time is reserved for hands-on skills, problem solving, and building upon core concepts.

1.5-Day Intensive Course with Expert Instructors

TNCC is a 1.5-Day Intensive Course that is taught by expert instructors.

21-Chapter Comprehensive Manual

The Trauma Nursing Core Course contains evidence-based content developed by trauma experts to reinforce and supplement the lectures and skill stations. It is a compilation of current trauma nursing standards and is a valuable resource for future reference.

Course Completion

Students will be tested on the Trauma Nurse Process (TNP). Access will be granted to the electronic exam after receiving a successful score of 70% or greater on the TNP. Students have 6 days to complete the open-book exam post-course completion. Students must score 80% or better on the exam to pass the course with in a 2-hour timeframe.

Pre-requisite Requirements

Completion of the ENA pre-course online modules is required before attending class. Information on how to access these modules will be sent to participants, along with their textbook, at least 30 days prior to the course.

The TNCC Provider Manual, Eight Edition, is included with course registration and is yours to keep.

There is an additional student workbook available for purchase, the cost is \$25.00. The TNCC, 8th Edition, Workbook and Study Guide is a brand-new learning resource that helps TNCC students focus their study. It is comprised of images from PowerPoint slides with space for notetaking and the teaching TNPs. You will be given a link to purchase this **optional** workbook and study guide in your class registration email from ENA.

Faculty:

All faculty are ENA trained by the national organization to instruct the TNCC course.
